



Class 2 Invalid Carriage



- Is an electric scooter or powerchair.
- Has a top speed of 4mph.
- Cannot be driven along the road, exceptions to this rule are when crossing the road or when there is no pavement.
- Can be suitable for both outdoor and indoor use.
- A class 2 scooter or powerchair does NOT need to be registered with the DVLA.
- Can only be driven by a person who has trouble walking because of an injury, physical disability, or medical condition. *
- * The exception to this is if you are demonstrating one before it is sold, taking it to or from being repaired or training a disabled person to use one.
